

Praise God!

The Body of Coordinators is excited to welcome you back to our CCGD Gathering beginning June 28th. We appreciate your efforts to love one another and live your Community Covenant even while we have been adhering to City, County, and Diocesan restrictions.

When we meet together once again, the safety of our Community and all those whom the Lord brings us are of paramount concern. Meeting in person will require some unfamiliar ways of interacting that might seem limiting. However, since our Lord commanded us to "Love one another" (Jn 13:34), all our new procedures will seem as nothing compared to the opportunity just to be together and see each other once again as God's Family.

In order that you might be better prepared to join our Sunday Gathering on June 28th, we want to communicate some of the new gathering procedures that will be necessary. Please note the following:

- *Our procedures will be evolving over time as medical, civil, and Church authorities recommend, and as prudence dictates in light of experience. Please stay engaged so you can remain aware of the latest procedures.*
- *We will initially restrict Sunday Gathering access at Mount St. Michael to the Foyer and Gym areas.*
- *When you arrive at the campus, please wear a mask or face covering.*
- *Masks should be worn except when seated at a suitable distance from others and when at the microphone.*
- *Upon entry into the gym, we'll have temperature check stations with proximity thermometers to provide a layer of health assurance.*
- *Please practice personal hygiene. This includes washing your hands regularly, using hand sanitizers, covering your mouth when coughing or sneezing, and avoiding unnecessary touching of common surfaces.*
- *Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be available for your use.*
- *Please practice physical distancing of at least 6 feet between persons of different households.*
- *For now, the water fountain will be closed. Please bring your own water should you need it during the Gathering. Bottled water will also be available if you forget.*

- *Please note and comply with all signage and practice personal responsibility in love during all interactions with your brothers and sisters in Christ. You may feel a strong urge to hug one another but please find alternative ways to express love while respecting social distancing.*
- ***If you are sick or have had contact with someone who has tested positive, please stay home until completing the recommended 14 day waiting period.***

When you enter the gym, you can expect to see a chair organization that allows for social distancing. You are welcome to move the chairs for your household to create additional separation as the gym will allow plenty of physical space.

For now, we will forgo discernment of words and simply invite anyone who has a Prophecy, Scripture, or sharing to go to the microphone if they feel such an anointing.

For now, rather than ending our Gatherings with a prayer circle for anointing and personal prayer, we will utilize an intercessory model. The leader of the Gathering will ask people in need of prayer to remain at their seats and will pray for all needs while maintaining social distancing.

What will not change is our commitment to seek the Lord, to listen to His voice, to embrace the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and to pour our lives out together for our God. We will continue offer Praise and Worship, to offer our full “Yes” to the Lord, and to love each other with all our hearts.

Blessings to each of you for your cooperation and patience. Please let us know what you think of the procedures, and how they are affecting you. Of course, our CCGD Covenant is rooted in love, so, if you are uncomfortable interacting at this time, please also feel free to remain home. Meanwhile, we pray that Our Lord showers us with His protection, discernment and wisdom, and that He shows us how to better love one another and to worship Him together during these challenging times.
